

YOU'LL NEED:

- 6" x 6" Spooktacular Designer Series Paper (no cutting to size)
- Tear & Tape Adhesive
- Ribbon
- Hole Punch
- Candy or small treats
- Embellishment or sentiment tag (I used "BOO to you!")



Mini Milk Carton Treat Box

USING SPOOKTACULAR DSP & TEAR AND TAPE ADHESIVE

FINISHED SIZE (APPROX.):

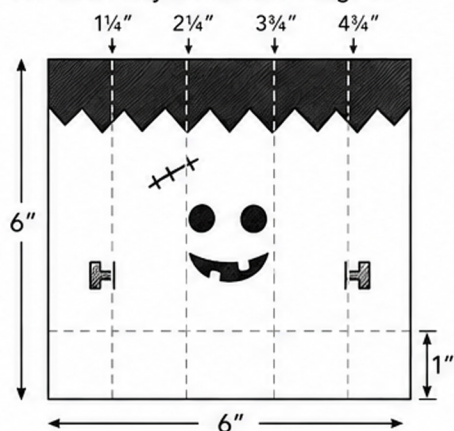
1.5" wide x 1" deep x 6" tall



1 SCORE THE DSP

Begin with a 6" x 6" piece of Spooktacular DSP. Position the paper so the face will be centered on the front.

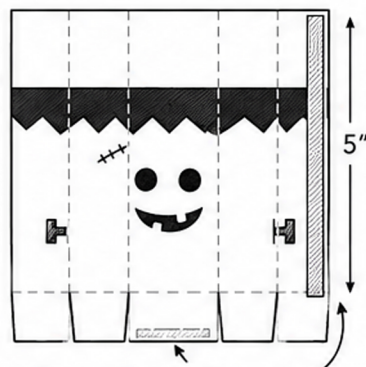
Score vertically from the left edge at:



Score horizontally
1" up from the bottom edge.

2 CUT & ADD TEAR & TAPE

Cut up each vertical score line from the bottom edge up to the 1" horizontal score line.



Add a 5" strip of Tear & Tape
along one vertical outside edge.

Add a 1 1/2" strip of Tear & Tape
to one of the bottom flaps.

3 FORM THE CARTON

Fold along all vertical score lines.



Remove the backing from the long
strip of Tear & Tape and adhere the
edges together to form the carton.



Fold in the bottom flaps.
Remove the backing from the 1 1/2"
Tear & Tape strip and press firmly
to seal the bottom closed.

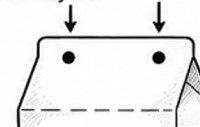
4 CREATE THE TOP

Add your Halloween treats
before closing the top.



Gently push the two short sides
inward while bringing the two
long sides together. The sides
will pinch inward, creating that
classic milk carton shape.

Press the top together, then
punch two holes through
both layers.



5 FINISH & DECORATE

Thread a piece of ribbon
through the holes and tie to hold the
carton closed.



Finish with your favorite
embellishments or sentiment.
