

YOU'LL NEED:

- 6" x 6" Spooktacular Designer Series Paper (no cutting)
- Tear & Tape Adhesive
- Candy or small treats
- Secret weapon: an empty toilet paper roll!

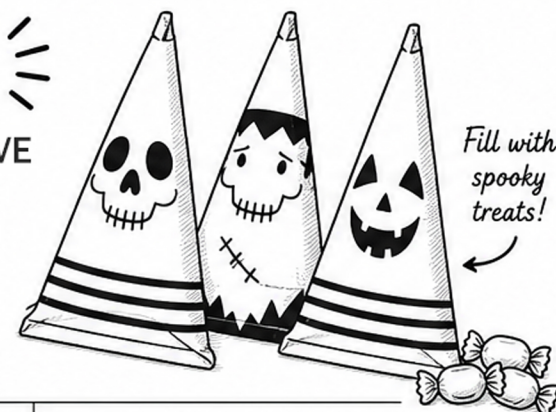


≡ Sour Cream Treat Pouch ≡

USING SPOOKTACULAR DSP & TEAR AND TAPE ADHESIVE

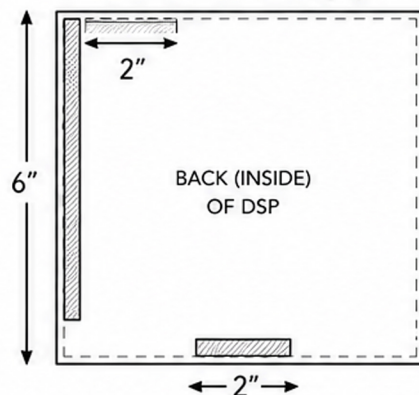
FINISHED SIZE (APPROX.):

2½" wide x 5½" tall
(Varies slightly depending on how full the pouch is.)



1 ADD THE TEAR & TAPE

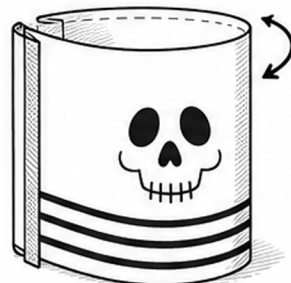
Turn the 6" x 6" DSP over so the inside/back side is facing up.



- Place a 6" strip of Tear & Tape along one outside edge.
- Place a 2" strip centered along the bottom edge.
- Place another 2" strip along the top edge, beginning at the corner beside the 6" strip and running perpendicular to it.

2 SHAPE THE POUCH – SECRET WEAPON!

Place an empty toilet paper roll on the DSP and gently wrap the paper around it to form a tube.



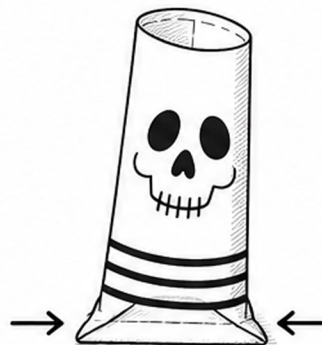
Remove the backing from the 6" strip of Tear & Tape and adhere the overlapping edges together.

★ CHRISTIE'S TIP:

Before sealing that long seam completely, push the toilet paper roll slightly out through the bottom. That makes it much easier to grab and remove once the seam is adhered.

3 SEAL THE BOTTOM

Remove the toilet paper roll.



Remove the backing from the 2" strip of Tear & Tape at the bottom, then gently smooch the bottom closed HORIZONTALLY and press firmly to adhere.

4 FILL & FINISH

Add your Halloween candy or treats.



Remove the backing from the remaining 2" strip of Tear & Tape at the top.

Turn the opening 90° from the bottom seam, then smooch the top closed VERTICALLY and press firmly to adhere.

♡ The opposite-direction closure (horizontal bottom & vertical top) creates that classic sour cream pouch shape! ♡
